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**Shaws Flat Road – SR 49 Intersection Improvement Project**

**Description**

Install upgraded LED-enhanced flashing stop and stop ahead signs, install transverse rumble strips, improve sight distance.

**Purpose and Need**

The Tuolumne County Roads Division of the Community Resources Agency compiles accident data records from the California Highway Patrol and Tuolumne County Sheriff, to perform continual monitoring and in-house analysis of "problem" locations where multiple accidents occur. This record gathering, monitoring, and analysis covers the entire Tuolumne County jurisdiction of County-maintained roads, and also includes incident data from state highways within the County.

Over the last decade, the intersection of State Route 49 and Shaws Flat Road has had many motor vehicle accidents; particularly, broadside and rear end accidents. The County aims to reduce the accident rate by analyzing and strategically improving the intersection.
