APPEALS HEARING:

9:00 A.M. GREENWORKS LLC APPEAL of a Tuolumne County Environmental Health Division Cease and Desist Order (C&O) issued on October 27, 2020. The C&O was issued in response to multiple fires located in composted material within the boundaries of Greenworks LLC's operating area.

Appeals Hearing Panel Background:

As part of our designation as Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), the Board of Supervisors has appointed an independent hearing panel consisting of three (3) members pursuant to section 44308 of the Public Resources Code (PRC). The purpose of this panel is to conduct hearings for appeals to permit denials or enforcement actions regarding permitted solid waste facilities.

In 1992, Resolution No. 80-92 established an independent hearing panel. The Public Resources Code number was changed from section 44801 to section 44308 through Assembly Bill No. 59, in 1995. Resolution No. 114-00 was adopted in 2000 to reflect these changes. Assembly Bill No. 2159 was codified in 2004 to add the option for a Hearing Officer and change the Hearing Panel member terms from two years to four years under PRC 44308(b)(5). Members may serve two consecutive terms.
