I have reviewed the 2012-2013 Tuolumne County Civil Grand Jury Report. The following is my response addressing the findings involving the Sonora Area office of the California Highway Patrol (CHP).

1. Page 34, Finding 3: Tuolumne County BHD staff is trained in all current policies, procedures, codes and protocols regarding a potential "5150" person. Page 34, Recommendation 3: It is suggested that all involved agencies and appropriate staff receive annual training relating to various aspects of "5150".

Response: Agree

The need for interagency corroborative training regarding law enforcement response to calls for service involving potential mental incapacitated individuals is needed.
