On January 14, 2023, President Joseph Biden declared a major disaster declaration FEMA-4683-DR, due to Severe Winter Storms, Flooding, Landslides and Mudslides beginning on December 27, 2022. As a result, the U.S. Department of Agriculture Farm Service Agency Emergency Loan Program has been made available for the primary counties of **Alameda, Butte, Calaveras, Colusa, Contra Costa, Fresno, Glenn, Humboldt, Los Angeles, Marin, Mendocino, Merced, Monterey, Placer, Sacramento, San Benito, San Joaquin, San Luis Obispo, San Mateo, Santa Barbara, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Siskiyou, Sonoma, Trinity, Tulare, Ventura, and Yolo** and the contiguous counties of **Alpine, Amador, Del Norte, El Dorado, Inyo, Kern, Kings, Lake, Madera, Mariposa, Modoc, Mono, Napa, Nevada, Orange, Plumas, San Bernardino, San Francisco, Shasta, Solano, Sutter, Stanislaus, Tehama, Tuolumne, and Yuba** in the State of California for both physical and crop production losses.
