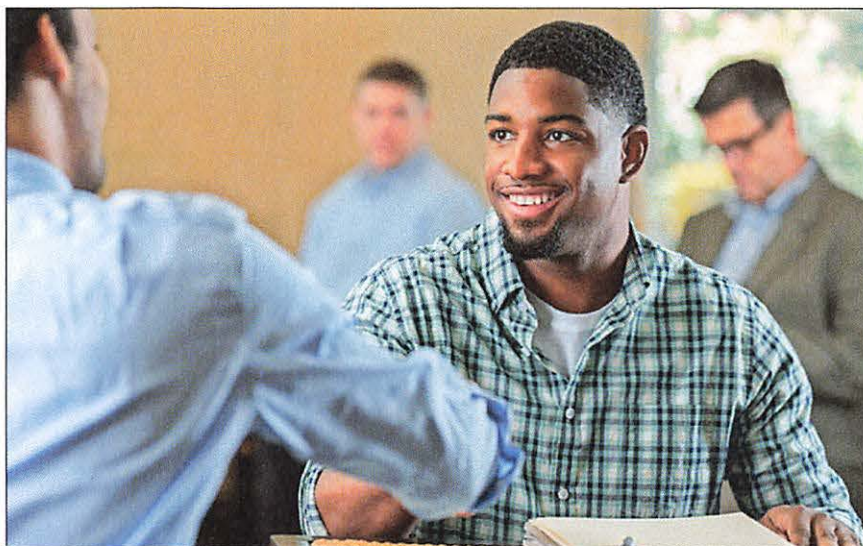


I'm working in California in another county as a Registered Environmental Health Specialist and want to advance in my profession. What options are available to me at Tuolumne County?

Plenty of options are available!

To attract the best and the brightest, we have created a career ladder that you would normally only find in the largest of California counties. For Senior Environmental Health Specialists in other counties that are not able to advance in their current counties, we have three positions to offer:

1. We offer Principal Environmental Health Scientist position that is the entry step into our management series of position classification. The person in this position receive both two weeks of paid annual leave and two weeks of paid management leave. You would be a lead for Environmental Health and, if it would meet your career goals, receiving training to move ahead in the management series. Here is a link to the classification:
