Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) Update

- **What it is:**
 - An operational plan focused on the overarching roles and responsibilities and coordination between various Tuolumne County government agencies (especially first responder agencies), jurisdictional and federal partners, private-sector partners, community groups, the public, etc., before, during, and after an emergency.
- **What it isn't:**
 - A plan listing every issue within the County and every emergency “what-if” scenario.
- **Whole-Community Approach**
 - Tribal Governments
 - CA Inclusive Planning
 - Access and Functional Needs
 - Cultural Competence

Why do an update? The EOP should be updated regularly to remain relevant and effective. Lessons learned from past events are incorporated into updates of the EOP.

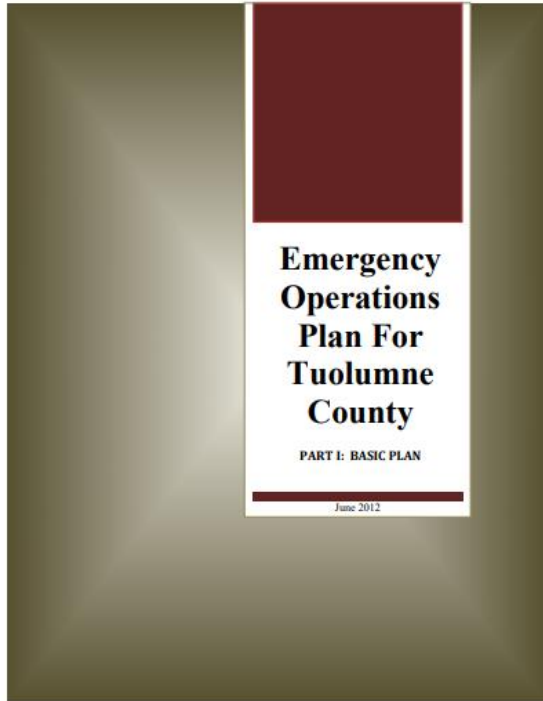


Project Process and Schedule
