



Tuolumne County Sanctioned Camp Program Participant Expectations & Rules

- Participants in the Sanctioned Camping Program are encouraged to engage in services and to move toward more suitable housing and healthy lifestyle choices as the Sanctioned Camping site is not for long-term stays. Call Tuolumne County Social Services at 209.533.5711 for more information on eligibility.
- Camping is allowed in designated spots only. Tent camping is on the right below the portable toilets in unassigned spots and RV's are on the left above the portable toilets in designated spots only.
- Construction of shelter or yard space is not allowed.
- Personal belongings must be contained in vehicles and tents and cannot be gathered or accumulated onsite.
- Only personal and operable vehicles are allowed.
- Urinating and defecating in provided toilets only.
- All garbage is to be placed in provided dumpsters.
- The following are not allowed: weapons, illegal drugs, alcohol, violent verbal or physical acts, open bonfires, or debris fires (cooking stoves are allowed), loud music.
- Pets must be restrained or crated and are not allowed to roam the property. Pet care and facility clean-up are the sole responsibility of the owner.
- The entire Sanctioned Camp site must be completely vacated for facilities maintenance and cleaning each week as posted.
