

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Tuolumne County's Economic Development Strategy for 2025-2030 outlines a comprehensive plan to foster sustainable growth, enhance the quality of life for residents, and ensure economic resilience. It argues true progress must address the root issues and create a foundation from which to grow.

The five key priorities identified are:



TOWN CENTER REJUVENATION

Revitalizing town centers focuses on enhancing the town centers within the county in order to encourage more foot traffic with longer stays from both residents and visitors, leading to more commerce, and leading to business attraction. This is accomplished through aesthetic appeal, functionality, and efforts to attract and retain businesses. This would be accomplished through:

- Improving Access: Upgrading sidewalks, lighting, and public spaces to create inviting environments for residents and visitors.
- Business Attraction and Retention: Providing incentives and support for local businesses to thrive, thereby attracting new enterprises and fostering entrepreneurship.
- Developing Services and Amenities: Providing amenities that cater to pedestrians and supporting businesses that serve specific needs, town centers can attract a wider range of visitors. Additionally, creating public spaces and parks will offer inviting areas for locals and travelers to gather, fostering a vibrant community atmosphere and supporting sustained economic growth in the town center.
- **Creating a Sense of Arrival and Place:** Create an environment which is welcoming and accommodating to many groups of people will encourage visitation.
- Marketing and Promotion: Highlighting what makes the town distinctive and accessible will draw attention from both regional and broader audiences.

HOUSING

- **Subsidize Costs**: Offer financial assistance to families transitioning from public assistance to ensure continuous access to childcare.
- **Workforce Development**: Provide training and support for childcare providers to enhance service quality.
