Funds may be awarded to new programs or to programs currently serving the needs of children at risk of abuse or neglect.

Services and Activities may include:

- Early developmental screening of children
- o Outreach services
- o Community referral services and follow up services,
- Respite care
- Childcare related to funded activities
- Family counseling
- Teaching and demonstration
- Family advocacy support
- Transportation
- o Child abuse prevention and education
