# Stormwater and Erosion Control After Wildfire for Residential Properties

As safety allows, use Best Management Practices to control ash from migrating during a rain event.

## What you will need:

- Gloves
- Shovel
- N95 or P100 mask
- Wooden stakes

- Hammer
- Water spray
- Fiber rolls/wattles
- Tarps

### Steps:

- If safe, cover ash/debris piles with a tarp and stake firmly in to the ground or other method, without disturbing or moving the footprint of the destroyed structure.
- Wet the area slightly where rolls will be placed to minimize dust.
- Bury roll 3" into the soil.
- Hammer stakes through the rolls around perimeter of ash piles and pay special attention to the areas where runoff could occur.

## **Installing fiber rolls/wattles:**
