Italian Bar Road crossing Rose Creek Bridge Replacement Project, Bridge No. 32C0037

Description

The proposed project is to replace the existing concrete bridge over Rose Creek with a new concrete single span bridge. The existing bridge is designated as 32C0037.

Purpose and Need

The purpose of this project is to provide the public a safe way of travel on the bridge located on Italian Bar Road crossing Rose Creek. The bridge was built in 1925 and has deficiencies in the concrete deck and superstructure, showing signs of efflorescence. The structure is considered structurally deficient and qualifies for replacement.

Strategic Plan Goals

Remove bridge from the Eligible Bridge List (EBL) within California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), Structure Maintenance and Investigations Division.

Funding Sources

Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), Highway Bridge Program (HBP) and California Toll Credits - 100% funded

Total Project Cost: \$2,337,775

This project is currently in the right-of-way phase.
